

Pacific Northwest Zone FNCC Application Process

Step 1

Submit a completed application and payment form to the Seattle Culture Center, attention Andrew Steiner, via email, fax or mail.

Step 2

Wait for notification of approval to conference, or notification of placement on the standby list.

Step 3

Procure airline reservations; submit a copy of said reservations to the Seattle Culture Center attention: Andrew Steiner.

Step 4

Enjoy a wonderful conference!!

Applications received without payment

Seattle Culture Center will call applicant to let them know that they cannot be confirmed or placed on standby without submitting their payment

Policy for Requesting a Single Room at the FNCC

Applicants may request a single room through the Pacific Northwest FNCC Coordinator, Andrew Steiner. It will be subject to availability and incurs an additional \$75 fee, no exceptions. Those requesting single rooms should visit the FNCC office upon arrival to the conference. If a single room is available, they must submit a payment of \$75 by cash or credit card. Checks or other forms of payment cannot be accepted.

Traveling Outside of the FNCC Scheduled Pickup Hours

The scheduled pickup hours for arrivals to FNCC are from 12:00pm to 6:00pm on the Friday of the conference. Applicants should know there are additional charges if their flights arrive to Florida outside of the arranged pickup hours.

The costs are as follows:

Miami International Airport to the FNCC: \$92.00

Fort Lauderdale Airport to the FNCC: \$58.00

The above fees include tip and must be paid by cash or credit card directly to the shuttle driver. The FNCC staff will make the arrangements with the shuttle company for pickup.

International Applicants to the FNCC

All international requests should be directed to Mahogany Gamble and may send their request to mgamble@sgi-usa.org. International applicants must have approval from their general director as well as the SGI-USA General Director to attend an FNCC conference.

Minimum Age Limit for FNCC Participants

This is a list of the exceptions to participants under the age of 16:

- The Family Conference 6-12, can participate together with their parents.
- For teenagers, the Jr. High and High School and Youth Performing Groups conferences that have a minimum age limit of 12.
- For other divisional, language or general conferences, the minimum age limit remains at 16 even if the minor would attend the conference with an adult.

Note: Any minor (under the age of 18) traveling alone must submit a minor consent form with their application and also keep one with them while traveling to the FNCC.
